

**CALL FOR SPECIAL ELECTION  
FOR THE IMPOSITION OF THE FLOATING HOMESTEAD LOCAL OPTION SALES  
TAX (FLOST)**

**TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF HOUSTON COUNTY, GEORGIA**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of May 2026, an election will be held at the regular polling places in all the election districts of Houston County, Georgia (“the County”), at which time there will be submitted to the qualified voters of the County for their determination the question of whether a one percent county floating homestead local option sales tax (the “FLOST”) shall be imposed on all sales and uses with the proceeds used exclusively to reduce property taxes imposed by Houston County and the municipalities of Centerville, Perry, and Warner Robins. The purpose of funding is specified in the form of the ballot set forth below.

- ( ) YES      Shall a special one (1) percent sales and use tax be imposed for 5 years within Houston County with the proceeds used exclusively to reduce property taxes
- ( ) NO      imposed by Houston County and the municipalities of Warner Robins, Perry and Centerville?

All persons who are not registered to vote and who desire to vote in the special election may register to vote through April 20, 2026.
