If continuation of the tax is approved by the voters, such vote shall also constitute approval of the issuance of general obligation debt of the Houston County School District in the principal amount of up to \$30,000,000, repayable from the proceeds of the aforesaid sales and use tax, for the purpose of funding such portions of the above projects as may be acquired, constructed, and equipped with the proceeds of general obligation debt. ☐ Yes ☐ No
